Exhibition: Accepted pieces will be displayed at the Winter Park Center For Health and Wellbeing, 2005 Mizell Ave, Winter Park (from November 2 - 30, 2023). Art must be able to hang on the wall and must be matted or framed. The Youth Services staff will attach self-adhesive tabs on the back of your artwork for hanging purposes. If you believe your art to be too heavy to be hung in this way, your submission should come equipped with the appropriate apparatus to support it. The Library reserves the right to remove and store exhibit pieces at the Library beginning December 1, 2023 if the artist fails to remove their work on the last day of the exhibit. Artist understands and agrees that the Library shall have no responsibility for the care of any exhibit piece and any loss or damage be the sole responsibility of exhibitor. Artist shall indemnify and hold the Library harmless against any and all claims arising out of this exhibit.

Media: All 2-D media are encouraged, but artwork must also be appropriate for public display.

Prizes: A jury panel will determine Best in Show and honorable merits. Winners will be announced at a Reception at the **Winter Park Center For Health and Wellbeing**, Saturday, November 18, from 10 a.m. – noon, and be awarded show ribbons and prizes.

Artists must be grades 8-12.
