Events adhere to the Library's procedures to accommodate social distancing guidelines. To accommodate this, face to face classes/events for ALL ages have a set capacity and require pre-enrollment. Please sign-up online at winterparklibrary.org.

All classes and events are FREE, unless otherwise specified, and you don't need a library card to sign up. Unless specified, all classes and events require enrollment to ensure supplies and seating. Those not enrolled may not be allowed to participate. Enrollment for classes the Library deems as "high demand" will have different sign-up times. Check the online calendar for details.

A parent or adult caregiver must attend classes or events with children under 9. Strollers must be parked outside of meeting rooms. Children under the age of 3 are not allowed to attend classes for youth 3+. 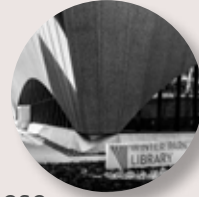

We have plenty of new spaces to explore. Familiarize yourself with room names and feel free to explore these spaces via our class offerings. Here is a small introduction to the new spaces and descriptions of what to can expect.



COMMUNITY ROOM

Located in the Children's area of the second floor is an expansive new meeting space. When combined with the adjacent Imagination Room, this new space allows Children's programming more flexibility and convenience.

EDYTH BUSH THEATRE
